This time it is me!!!! It's an attempt to address all of the issues that many of you have come to us with over the last few months.

Walk Offs, yes it happens!

We have had a few instances of players "walking off" courts because they don't like the mix of players or they get frustrated mid game with the level of play. Folks, that's not who we are. If it's OPEN PLAY and not designated levels then it is what it is. Please be kind.

Court Instructors, nope that's not you!

Yes, some of you are better than others. But It's not a good idea to instruct your partner or others mid game. If you want to have a discussion after the game and give some guidance, then by all means do so if the player is receptive. But geesh, mid game, no thanks.

Out Balls

Yup, again....calling questionable balls "out" is prevalent with a handful of us. If it's too close to call, it's in. If neither of you really saw it, it's in. Be courteous and for goodness sake calling "out" balls that are not really out is a cheap way to win! And never ever call a ball "out" before it lands!



Rotating through Open Play Protocol (again)

You all should know this by now but it's worth repeating.

WINNERS STAY and Split after a game. 2nd PLACE players come off the court.

IF YOU PLAY TWO GAMES IN A ROW you must come off the court. Again, geesh, most of you should know this by now.

Finding your Level

Here's how we look at it, please be mindful and honest with yourself.

You will need to figure out where you should be playing based on the following Guidelines. Court skill assignments are not meant to box anyone into one court. At any time, players can move to the court above or below their level. This will allow players to compete one level higher and will help them improve. You should, however, be considerate and not move levels until you have achieved the appropriate skills to offer a good game at that level.

Beginner/Novice

- First timers and novice. First timers please ask us about free Intro Lessons.
- Can hit simple shots
- Basic understanding of rules
- Sustains short rally
- Basic ability to keep score
- Developing technique and fundamental skills.

Intermediate

- Understands rules, strategy and court position.
- Regularly uses dinks and lobs
- Can hit a mix of shots
- Sustains medium length rallies
- Consistently gets serve/return in play
- Plays at the non-volley zone

Advanced

- Mastered the game.
- High level of consistency with a variety of shots including lobs, spin, dinks and drive shots with a purpose and at the right time.
- Experienced in competitive play
- Sustains long rallies
- Limited unforced errors
